

## Senior January Exam Rules 2018

## PRIOR TO EXAMS:

- Carefully read your exam schedule. Take time to highlight the exams you will be writing, check the information with the subject teacher and write it in your agenda.
- Students are to report any exam conflicts to the office **immediately**.
- Students are expected to be on school premises 20 minutes prior to the exam start time.
- Students are reminded to verify the **exam schedule** located on each floor for the location of their exam or the television screen located in the school.

## **DURING THE EXAMS:**

- Students must wear their full uniform during the examination period. They will not be allowed to write an exam unless they comply with the uniform code.
- At the start of the exam, students will sign the attendance sheet.
- They will be permitted to leave an examination only after half the exam time has elapsed (minimum time one hour).
- Students will not be permitted to enter the exam room **half an hour after** the start of the exam. Extra time is not given to students who arrive late.
- Students must bring all relevant supplies to each exam: the school will **not issue** supplies. Dictionaries, calculators etc., can only be used if the subject teacher has instructed students to do so and it is indicated in the exam's instructions.
- Cheating during an exam will result in a 0 for the exam and the student will be expelled from the exam room.
- Coats, bags, food, books, notes and hats are not permitted in the exam room. Water bottles will be permitted if they are placed beside the student's seat.
- Electronic devices (cell phone, Blackberry, computer, translator, smartwatch, etc.) are not permitted in the exam room. If the device is in the student's possession during an exam, it will be considered cheating. It will result in a mark of 0 for the exam. The item will be confiscated and the student will be expelled from the exam room.
- All personal belongings should be stored in the student's locker. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items that students leave at the front of the exam room.
- Students are to be in school **only** when **writing examinations** unless attending planned tutorials with a teacher.
- The cafeteria will be closed during the week of exams.
- If for any reason, the school is closed for a day, the examination will be rescheduled and the notice will be posted outside the main entrance and on the school website.
- In the case of **absence** from an examination, a **medical certificate** is required: otherwise a mark of 0 will be given. <u>Misreading the schedule is not an acceptable excuse.</u>
